Min 1. 17/05/2019: Introduction

The meeting started at 10:50am with a word of prayer by Joel Maritim there after the chairman welcomed all the members and confirmed the previous minutes of the last meeting then followed a session of self-introduction.

Min2.17/11/2019: opening of exit and entrance

The market members requested that the set-up of the market is so closed-up and they are requesting the county government to open the entrance and exit to link the market and the bus park. Juliana Ngetich embassies that the market need flow of vehicles and people so as the make the market vibrant and be known. Mrs Ngetich proposed and was seconded by Mr. Julius Rotich

To those who will be affected the market members agreed that agreed that those who are in market will be allocated to available spaces in the market and those in the other site of bus park, The County Government to negotiate and see how they can assist them. Attached by affected list

Min3.17/11/2019: General set-up of the market

The market members further requested the municipality to put up more kiosk in the market to help those who are in need of the said kiosk.

Mrs. Vicky Chepkorir proposed to the meeting that there was enough available space in the market which can be used by vendors in more productive way. She further suggested that the County Government should come up with standard measures and plans to counter for the same.

Min 4.17/11/2019: Market Rental Fee

Lower Market Ag chairman requested that the rates be hold until April 2020 because the business in the Lower market has not picked up hence vendors would not meet required payments of rates.

Min5. 17/11/2019: Planning of the market

Mr. Cheruiyot the chairman suggested the planning proposals be made for well organized. The Administrator agrees that the agenda to be taken back to the market and planned.

Min6.17/11/2019: Works

The chairman suggested that the contractor doing some works didn't complete the work, it was then suggested that engineer to do thorough inspection and make a report. The committee also emphasized on electricity for quality work to be done and Administration to follow on the issue of electricity. The stalls also be marked/ numbered to ease identification.

Min7. 17/11/2019: Enforcement

Mr. Kipkemoi reported that there is a big challenge concerning enforcement. He further pointed out that patrolling dealing with vendors selling outside the market to be done on daily basis of which the town administrator was given a task to coordinate on enforcement issues.

Min8. 17/11/2019: Closed Kiosks

The committees mentioned some kiosks which are still closed upto now and it was agreed by the members who were present that all kiosks which are still closed be allocated to other business people who are on the waiting list.

Min.8/17/11/2019: Other suggestions

The market Chair suggested to the meeting, that as the municipality continues to great exit and entrance, they should also consider proper drainage to the market and possibly the leveling and gravelling of the market grounds and if possible, the market to put cabro work.

Min.9/17 /05/2019: Adjournment

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:00 pm with a word of prayers led by Julius Kipkemoi
